At Adient, we hold ourselves and our suppliers to the highest ethical standards. As stated in our Terms and Conditions, we expect our suppliers to conduct business consistent with all applicable laws and regulations. Adient is committed to compliance with all international trade laws.

Consistent with that commitment, we remind you that Adient expects that our suppliers will not directly or indirectly have dealings with an entity that has been sanctioned by the United Nations, the United States, the European Union or by any country with or in which Adient conducts business.

Adient and its suppliers must meet all legal and regulatory requirements and Adient takes this commitment seriously. This includes prohibiting use of forced labor and sanctioned parties anywhere in our supply chain (e.g., suppliers, smelters, distributors, freight forwarders, carriers, customs brokers).

Our suppliers must support these efforts and have effective controls to address risk in the supply chain. Should a supplier refuse to cooperate with our compliance efforts, Adient may reevaluate our supply arrangement and implement remedies available to us.
